Elective Classes

Music - Year Long/Daily - Music at LMS is a class of either Band, Strings or Choir. If you are currently enrolled in either Band, Strings or Choir at LIS you are encouraged to continue in your current choice for next year.

Physical Education - Semester/Daily - PE is a course that teaches and engages students in many elements of health, fitness and game play.

Art - Semester/Daily - Art is a course in which students engage in project based learning to learn skills and create using various mediums.

STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) - Semester - We are excited to offer the beginner course of the Project Lead the Way Program. This course focuses on Design and Modeling. The class will be very hands on through use of computer based design programs along with actual model construction.

Digital Arts - Semester/Daily - Students in Digital Arts will use their creative skills to do projects that could include game design, photography, videography, animation, etc.
