

# Levy FACTS

Loveland City School District has a 4.9 mill operating levy on the ballot on May 2, 2023. If approved, property taxes would increase by \$172 per year for each \$100,000 in county auditor appraised home value. The levy would allow the district to continue delivering a high quality education for students.

## If the Levy Passes



- Continued fiscal responsibility to maintain low expenditures per student
- Maintain class sizes, student support, and course offerings

## If the Levy Fails



- State fiscal distress process begins
- Increase class sizes
- Fewer course offerings
- Need for revenue continues
- Move towards State minimum services

\$14.33 per month for every \$100,000 in appraised home value



Half of all Ohio districts spend more per student
